- Library
- Search the web
- Scientific search, e.g.
 - <http://portal.acm.org/portal.cfm>
 - <http://www2.computer.org/portal/web/guest>
 - <http://citeseer.ist.psu.edu/>
 - ...
- Talk to your advisor. If there are papers which are not available he might help you to get them.

What you should do:

- Your structure should
- Describe and compare the different papers you find/get
- Point out things you think are good or bad in the paper and why you think so
- Cite to prove what you write
- Mention the literature you used
